General Information

Key Times:

- **Departure:** We will be meeting on Friday November 20th at Wapping Church at 6:20pm. We plan to leave promptly at 6:20pm **so plan to be there by 6:00**. Scouts should already have had dinner before departure.
- **Returning:** Sunday November 22nd at about 11:00 am
- **Cost:** \$8.00

About the trip:

This camping trip will pit our troop's Scouting skills against other troops in South Windsor at JN Webster BSA camp. On Saturday, patrols will complete head-to-head on several new and challenging events.

Patrols will be determined prior to the trip and an e-mail will be sent to each Scout attending the trip informing him of his patrol assignment. The Patrols will be responsible for breakfast on Saturday and Sunday and dinner on Saturday. Lunch will be provided (hot dogs, chips, soup and a beverage).

November weather can be cold, so Scouts will need to be prepared for possible cold weather camping.

All Scouts and leaders should sign-up early.

FOOD

This is patrol cooking. Each scout will be assigned to a patrol. The Patrol Leader will COORDINATE the menu and purchasing of the food. They (PLs) should not do all the work themselves. A Patrol Leader will be assigned shortly.

Meals will be judged. Patrols are responsible for cooking 2 breakfasts and 1 dinner. All meals must include 2 hot items!!! We will provide lunch on Saturday.

Other Troops:

Two other troops from South Windsor (186 and 62) will be camping and competing against us. This is going to be a lot of fun.

Location:

We will be camping at Camp JN Webster, Ashford, CT. Site 5.

Directions:

From Route I-84/Hartford:

Take I-84 east to exit 69 (Route 74). Take Route 74 east to Route 44. Turn left on Route 44 and travel approximately 2 miles to the camp entrance, which is on the left. The hope is that we are in Site 5 which is located below the main parking area.
