

May 7th Work Day at Wapping Church Park

WHEN

Sat May 7th from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM

WHERE

Wapping Church Park (the wooded area across Petersen Way from the church)

WHAT

The wooded area across Petersen Way from the church was made into a small park area last year as part of an Eagle project. After the sudden passing of Bob King (Scoutmaster of Troop 62 and a very active church member) it was decided to dedicate the park to him.

However, the area became ravaged over the winter and looks terrible. It is in dire need of a cleanup before we can dedicate the area to our friend.

The Wapping Church Property Trustees (the group that sponsors Troop 880) are looking for volunteers to cleanup the area before the dedication.

Scouts and Leaders from both Troop 62, Troop 880 as well as people from the church are needed.

This is a great way for us to give back to the church as well as pay respect to a dedicated Scout Leader, father and church member.

Rakes, saws, chain saws are all needed. Also is there anyone with access to a chipper. The bigger the better so we can create our own wood chips. The fire ring, made of cinder blocks, would look better if surrounded by rocks.

Anyone who has med-large rocks to get rid of is asked to bring them. Embedding them in Quick-crete should look good as well as protect from vandalism.

Note: gloves, long pants and long sleeve shirts are recommended since there is poison ivy in the area.
